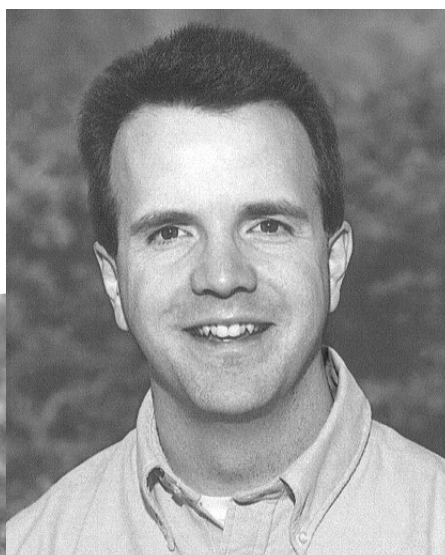
“I would like to remember my father who passed away during a previous election. He and my mother have given me the support and ‘guard rails’ that I have needed for my life.

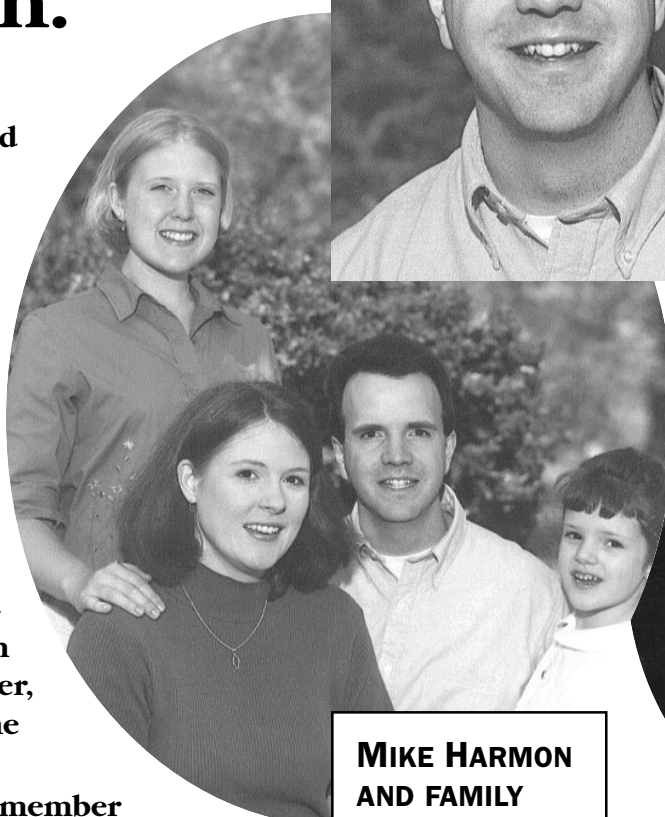

Mike has received the official endorsement of the Kentucky Right to Life Assoc. PAC, and he is Sunday school director and a deacon of his church.



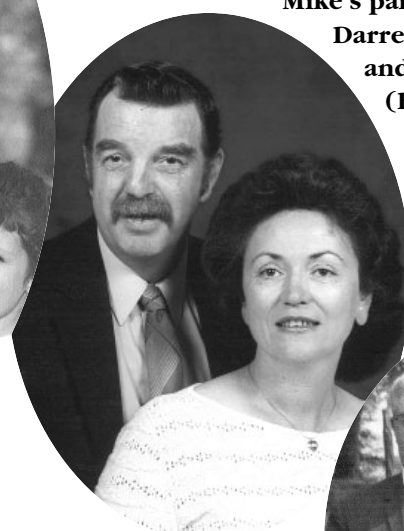
